



Service Officer Column for Newsletter

This month I would like to discuss Service Connected Compensation for Agent Orange. This will apply to you if you served in Vietnam between January 9, 1962 and May 7, 1975 or you served in Korea along the DMZ between April 1, 1968 through August 31, 1971. If you have any of the following health conditions, you should contact me as soon as possible so we can discuss a possible claim with the VA for you. The health conditions associated with Agent Orange are: Chloracne, Porphyria Cutanea Tarda, Soft-tissue Sarcoma, Hodgkin's disease, Multiple myeloma, Respiratory cancers (lung, bronchus, larynx, trachea), Non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma, Prostrate Cancer, Acute and Sub Acute Peripheral Neuropathy, Type 2 Diabetes, Chronic Lymphocytic Leukemia, Ischemic Heart Disease, B Cell Leukemia, ALS or Parkinson's Disease. Please call me if you have any questions. Just received notice that bladder cancer and/or diesel fuel exposure is now service connected due to Agent Orange exposure.
