Service Officers Report

The recent VA report of reducing their backlog, by over 60%, has apparently had but little improvement on the timeliness of resolving open claims. In the past few months, several of the veterans I have consoled report the same lag, by the VA, of keeping them advised of the status of their claims as we all have seen in the past years. Recently, discussing one such claim with an Oakland County service officer, I learned that the VA sent a veteran a denial touching only on one part of an active claim. When pushed to research that response, that officer found that the VA was still processing another portion. It would have been nice of them to state such in their correspondence.

I don't believe there will ever be a perfect system for keeping up with claims and appeals in the VA. All we can do is to each keep copies of everything submitted and acknowledge that vigilance on our part is the key to acquiring the benefits promised us. If you have a claim, even one that was granted some time ago, and have new information, such as a change in your disability, please bring it to my attention. There may be an opportunity to file for an increase in care and compensation.
