





## **Service Officer Letter:**



Show me any correspondence you receive and I will see you get the latest intel on such.

The Board has put together a document that details how a veteran can request emergency financial aid. This is a multi-step process to be followed in sequence. It takes in account existing procedures at the State and County levels. Not to say Post 1008 won't consider every request. We want to be certain that veterans use the resources available to them at State and County first. After all, their pocket books are deeper than ours.
