## FULFILLING OUR NATION'S PROMISE - POW / MIA

Once an excavation site has been identified a recovery team is activated. That recovery team of 10 -14 people includes a team leader, a recovery leader (a forensic anthropologist or an archaeological anthropologist), a team sergeant, a linguist, a medic, a life support technician, a communications technician, a forensic photographer, an explosive ordnance disposal technician and

several mortuary affairs specialists. Missions last 35 - 60 days with teams traveling with up to 10,000 pounds of survival and excavation equipment.

In Fiscal Year 2018 203 formerly missing persons were accounted for. Vietnam War - 10 Korean War - 37 World War II - 156 SEPTEMBER 20, 2019 POW / MIA RECOGNITION DAY


On November 10th we hold our annual Veteran and Auxiliary Member of the Year Award banquet. The event starts at 1pm, please bring a dish to pass.
