Karla Meadows-La Forge POW/MIA COMM. OF MICHIGAN, National League of POW/MIA Families, Post #1008 Auxiliary, Heart of the Lakes

The National League of Families of American prisoners and missing in Southeast Asia, just had our 50th Anniversary annual meeting June 19-23, 2019. This was a monumental accomplishment / milestone, considering the struggle this issue has endured since the beginning of our Charter in 1970. For me personally this was my 41st annual meeting.

Current standings of the missing as of June 14, 2019 - 1,588 Americans are now listed by the DOD (Department of Defense) as missing and unaccounted for - KIA (killed in action) / BNR (body not returned) from the Vietnam War: Vietnam - 1,246 (VN-443, VS-803) 90%; Laos - 287; Cambodia - 48; People's Republic of China territorial Waters - 7.

A total for the accounted since the end of the war in 1975 is 995. A breakdown by country of these 995 Americans is: Vietnam - 672, Laos - 278, Cambodia - 42, and the PRC - 3. In addition, 63 US Personnel were accounted for between 1973 and 1975, the formal end of the Vietnam War for a grand total of 1,058.

The great state of Michigan began with the original "77" POW/MIA's. Since then our number is down to 48 still missing, unaccounted for, or BNR. Since 1970 we have accounted for 29 Michigan missing. And for anyone who's interested, we happen to have one right from our own Township of Waterford, - SMSGT. Douglas V. Daily, USAF-12/13/68, LAOS.



I hope we can show our support for this issue on September 20, 2019 which will be National POW/MIA Recognition Day at Oakland Hills Cemetery, Novi.

The identification and internment of CDR James B Mills, USN, brother of Ann Mills-Griffith, President of the National League of Families took place at Arlington National Cemetery the day after the close of the annual meeting. Those with proper credentials were allowed to attend the internment. Karla LaForge was among those attending and shares these photos of the internment. She writes, 'this was truly chilling and an awesome experience'.

DID YOU KNOW ?????

There are many people to thank in the historical background of Post 1008. With the various mergers over the years, it presents an interesting history. Post 1008, founded on February 7, 1950 as Water Wonderful Post 1008. At this point, the Post was meeting in the American Legion Hall on Paddock and Pike.

Members of VFW Post 1370 formerly met in the basement of a local bar located on Saginaw and Rapid St., owned by Paul Parks. Several members of Post 1370 would later transfer to Post 1008 to bolster the ranks of the Post. I

In 1964, the David Belisle Post 4102 of Drayton Plains merged with Post 1008. Stanley Stewart was the Commander of Post 4102 and served as the interim Commander until the post-election of 1965. The merged posts merged under the number 1008, opened on October 15th, 1967, and elected Clell L. "Mutt" Morse as its first Commander.

The purchase of the current post building is a true story of dedication and faith in the importance of Post 1008. Five members stepped forth and determined to give Post 1008 a home of its own. Clell "Mutt" Morse, George Pappas, Dixie White, Kenneth Gilmore and Robert Almas risked everything when they collateralized their homes to take a 25 year mortgage on the property at 1690 Airport Road. With the money secured, they also helped to renovate an old airframe machine shop into a rental hall and Veterans of Foreign Wars post. No member of Post 1008 will ever forget the level of commitment these individuals exhibited.

In 1993, the Post merged yet again, this time with the David Belisle Post 1008 and Heart of the Lakes (Keego Harbor) Post 2706. In a symbolic act of unification, the family of David Belisle gave permission for the name of the post to change to Heart of the Lakes to welcome the new membership from Post 2706, while keeping the Post 1008 number. The first Commander of the newly unified post was *Richard Coe*.

Undoubtedly, many people have strived to keep Post 1008 open and thriving so that it can continue to serve the needs of our veteran community.



Requests for financial aid from our Oakland County Servicemen's Relief Fund are way down this year. Is that a good thing, or have we failed to get the word out to more recent veterans?


As of this month, the VA has not published any guidelines for Vets who want to use local medical facilities in lieu of VA Hospitals and Clinics. Should you wish to try doing so, please telephone your Primary Care Office and request approval. In an emergency, you have but 24 hours to do so. You must not offer any other medical insurance card to the facility. The VA will handle negotiations of that bill and then use your recorded policy to settle.
