<u>Accountability:</u> At the end of the Vietnam War, there reportedly were 2,583 unaccounted-for American prisoners, missing or killed in action/body not recovered. As of January 21, 2020, the Department of Defense lists 1,587 Americans as missing and unaccounted-for, 90% of them in Vietnam or in areas of Cambodia and Laos where Vietnamese operated during the war. A breakdown by year of recovery for the <u>996 Americans accounted for from Vietnam War-related losses post April 30, 1975 follows:</u>

April 11th is the Easter Egg Hunt for the children from 11am to 1pm. This is a great time for all; help is needed to make this a success.


April 15th is the Auxiliary meeting. This meeting is important to attend as it is election of officers for the year of 2020-21. All positions are open, come make next year a success.

VA updates the disability rating schedule for infectious diseases, immune disorders and nutritional deficiencies

As of Aug. 11, (2019) the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) updated portions of the <u>VA Schedule for Rating Disabilities</u> (VASRD, or Rating Schedule) that evaluate infectious diseases, immune disorders and nutritional deficiencies.

The collection of federal regulations used by the Veterans Benefits Administration helps claims processors evaluate the severity of disabilities and assign disability ratings.

"VA is in the process of updating all 15 body systems of the VASRD to more accurately reflect modern medicine and provide Veterans with clearer rating decisions," said VA Secretary Robert Wilkie. "By updating the rating schedule, Veterans receive decisions based on the most current medical knowledge of their condition."

The complete list of updates to the rating schedule is available <u>online</u>. Claims pending prior to Aug. 11, will be considered under both the old and new rating criteria, and whichever criteria is more favorable to a Veteran will be applied. Claims filed on or after Aug. 11, will be rated under the new rating schedule.

There is more but I have limited space. See ya at the Post.




